

Toyota Auris Hybrid

The hybrid version of the Toyota Auris was the first of its type to be built in the UK and can produce impressive fuel economy of 74.3mpg (10% BIK). When driving in towns and cities, the vehicle can save owners even more in fuel costs through the EV mode. This fully-electric setting uses no petrol at all when travelling at speeds under 31mph, as well as cuts out all audible engine noise.

The low CO₂ emissions produced by the vehicle – just 89g/km – also mean that owners pay no road tax, while London-based drivers are also exempt from the congestion charge.

The environmental and fuel economy credentials of the Auris Hybrid are not the only factors to attract the discerning motorist. When required, it is possible to switch the vehicle to Power Mode, where the two engines work together to provide an impressive 136bhp. This is capable of providing a level of performance superior to many cars with a bolder reputation.
